

RICHARDSON PREP HI ELECTION RULES

Student Government is a privilege granted to those who EARN the desired position. Strict adherence of the Richardson PREP HI Constitution will be followed to maintain the high standards that an ASB position warrants.

Please carefully read the following rules that will be in effect throughout the election process and upheld throughout your term as an ASB member here at Richardson. Place a check () by each of the following items to indicate that you meet eligibility requirements and will abide by all election rules.

- _____ 1. A student must have a grade of "C" or higher in academics, and an "S" or higher in effort, citizenship or work habits on **all** report cards for the school year.
- _____ 2. A student must have at least a 2.5 GPA on 1st Semester report card to be eligible for office.
- _____ 3. A student whose name has appeared on the Discipline List may be ineligible. Any student who received a Step 3 or Step 4 for the school year or who is presently on probation is not eligible.
- _____ 4. Each student must complete and pass the application process by the deadline to be considered for eligibility.
- _____ 5. Each student may only place posters outside the cafeteria, library, B-Wing, C-Wing, and in classrooms with teachers' approval. No other locations are permitted. Only masking tape and clear tape may be used to hang posters (no duct tape, glue or staples). **You may begin putting up posters on the designated day only.**
- _____ 6. A student who creates offensive posters or is involved in the destruction of another candidate's posters will be disqualified.
- _____ 7. Each student must be responsible for the removal of campaign materials following the election.
- _____ 8. Failure to abide by ASB Election Rules or Richardson's Contract will immediately disqualify a student from running for or holding office.
